In its endeavor to provide quality Accounting, Finance, Tax, Audit and Management Consultancy personnel to recruiting entities, the Committee has successfully organised one more round of Campus Placement Programme for Newly Qualified Chartered Accountants at nineteen centres viz. Ahmedabad, Bangalore, Baroda, Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh, Chennai, Coimbatore, Ernakulam, Hyderabad, Indore, Jaipur, Kolkata, Mumbai, Nagpur, Navi Mumbai, New Delhi, Pune, Thane & Vasai in August-September-October, 2014.

Executive Summary

1. Highest salary offered for Domestic posting in the Campus Placement Programme is Rs. 17 lacs Per Annum offered by ITC Limited.
2. Highest salary offered for International posting in the Campus Placement Programme is Rs. 24 Lacs per annum offered by Alghanim Industries at New Delhi center to 4 candidates.
3. Average CTC offered is Rs 7.29 Lacs Per Annum.
4. 1019* jobs were offered to the candidates who had participated in Campus Placement Programme.
5. 86 organizations and 154 Interview Teams have participated during the Campus Placement Programme.

Salient features

1. Candidates were given two chances to meet the recruiting organisations via opting for two centers, first at smaller center and second (if the candidates has not been selected at smaller centers) at bigger centers.
2. The committee organised Orientation Programme for candidates so as to sharpen their soft skills and to provide them technical updates.
